She also recently installed a creation for the Second Alarmers Fire Fighters Support Hall to commemorate their anniversary. Not too shabby for someone who started her career airbrushing T-Shirts. Angel will be missed the most by all of us in the family, but the art world will also feel the loss greatly. We will
